In addition, **over 50 parents** are journeying in faith through the **CCO Discovery Program**—a beautiful witness to growth in family faith.

Each session begins in the gym, filled with **prayer, song, and energy**, before children head to their classrooms led by our dedicated catechists who are doing amazing work.

We had an **Adoration/Taizé session** on November 21st for the confirmation candidates (Grade 8 and 9) led by Father Peter Osborne.
