THE CHURCH CELEBRATES OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY THROUGHOUT OCTOBER, AND THE FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY ON OCTOBER 7TH

In the 12th century, Our Lady appeared to St. Dominic and taught him a specific method to teach Christians the truths of SALVATION (Joyful Mysteries), REDEMPTION (Sorrowful Mysteries), and ETERNAL LIFE (Glorious Mysteries). After which, St. Dominic would give a short teaching on each of the mysteries, and lead the people in 10 Hail Mary's. The Virgin Mary told him that this form of prayer would one day be one of the most powerful weapons against future errors and difficulties. Indeed, the Bible tells us that the Virgin Mary was chosen by God before the foundations of the world were laid in place, to smite the head of the servant through the humility of her fiat. On October 7, 1571, Pope Pius V organized a Rosary Crusade to fight advancing Muslim forces hoping to conquer Europe, turn St. Peter's Basilica into a mosque, and destroy Christianity. The Pope asked the faithful to pray the rosary. The Christian Crusade, outnumbered 7 to 1, won the Battle of Lepanto against the Ottoman forces, when winds at sea suddenly changed; the victory was attributed to Our Lady of the Rosary. Join in a parish rosary from your homes on October 7th, to pray for your intentions. And this weekend, please pick up the short Memorare prayer used by St.Theresa of Calcutta as a mini novena to Our Lady in emergencies - just recite it 9 times at once, in place of a 9-day rosary novena (The Memorare prayer is available on the table at the front left entrance of the church, across from St Joseph's altar).






ROSARY RALLY
