### DIOCESAN FEAST DAY and CONFERRAL OF DOLLARD MEDAL OF MERIT

Bishop Christian Riesbeck, CC, cordially invites the faithful of the diocese to celebrate our patronal feast day, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, and gather for a concelebrated Eucharist on Monday, December 8, at 6:30 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Saint John. During this Mass, in honor of the Jubilee Year and the 170<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Cathedral, the Bishop Dollard Medal of Merit will be conferred on eight individuals from the three regions of our diocese. The Dollard Medal is the highest honor bestowed upon a member of the lay faithful in the Diocese of Saint John. This distinction, named in honor of Bishop William Dollard, our first bishop, recognizes individuals whose lives radiate the Christian virtues of faith, hope, and love, and who have contributed significantly to the life and mission of the Church. A reception will follow in the Cathedral residence. All are invited to attend.

We are still moving full speed ahead and continue to welcome new children registering for our program Faith Formation Program — thank you for your continued support!


