November 2 is All Souls Day, dedicated by the Church to all the departed souls in purgatory - while saved, they must yet be purified in purgatory before entering heaven. The church dedicates the entire month of November to the Souls in Purgatory, and we are tasked with praying for them because they can no longer pray for

themselves. The time given to attain merit for ourselves, through our prayers, is while we are living. In purgatory, the soul is in a state of justice for its offences committed while on earth, and must be completely purified before entering heaven. The teaching of the church is clear:

Souls in Purgatory cannot pray for themselves to help them reach heaven, but they can, and do, pray for us, both while they are in purgatory and, later, in gratitude to us, once they enter heaven. They are part of the universal church and we are urged to pray for them to lessen their time of purification.

St. Gertude the Great, a Benedictine nun and mystic, received a vision from Jesus in which He gave her a prayer to recite for the Holy Souls and told her that each time she recited it, 1000 souls would be released from purgatory, and that the suffering of the HOLY SOULS would be greatly reduced. The Church tells us not to focus on numbers but on fervently saying the prayer, letting God take care of the details. It has been prayed for 800 years.

**On November 1**st, St Dunstan's will be offering this prayer on the table across from St Joseph's altar (left front of the Church). Say this short prayer all through the year but especially throughout November, or say it each day for 9 days as a novena, or add it after each decade of the

rosary. The mass is the strongest prayer there is, so also say masses for the Holy Souls, whether requested through the office to be said by a priest, or simply by dedicating the masses you attend for the Holy Souls.




Diane Flynn will be collecting for the Televised Mass sponsored by our Parish.
