We will gather as a community for prayer, devotions, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Reconciliation, and attend the Jubilee Pilgrimage Mass. The St. Mary Magdalene Parish Outreach Ministry to the Fredericton Community Kitchens began in 2018, through the leadership of John Denning, as an ecumenical initiative with Wilmot United Church to help provide food security for some of the most vulnerable members of the Fredericton community. Wilmot United did not continue after Covid. St. Mary Magdalene parishioners stepped up and formed four new teams, plus a list of spares, to ensure that the supper shift would be covered every Sunday. This continued as a rewarding ministry for many parishioners until August 24, 2025.

The Community Kitchens' administration has chosen to move forward with a different model for the Sunday supper shift, opening it to volunteers from the greater Fredericton area. Some of our volunteers will continue with that shift, some will volunteer for the 2pm - 4pm Sunday shift or other shifts, while others are choosing to pursue other volunteer opportunities.

Father Suresh, Father Peter and the whole Parish wish to express sincere gratitude to all those parishioners who participated, through the years, in our Outreach Ministry to the Community Kitchens and followed the Gospel message of Jesus, giving generously of their time and gifts to feed the hungry. To recognize their contributions to our parish and to the Fredericton community, all Community Kitchen volunteers will be invited to a meal in their honour to be held after Father Suresh returns from his vacation. The Executive Director of the Fredericton Community Kitchens, Cassandra LeBlanc, has also expressed thanks for the dedication and commitment of our St. Mary Magdalene volunteers.
